Tulong Tomasino Relief and Cash Donation Campaign

Campaign Period: August 17-31

Standard items containing the Tulong Tomasino Relief Box*

Food Items <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 5 kilos of rice• 6 liters of mineral water• 1 kilo of sugar• coffee (100 grams)• 1 kilo of powdered milk• 1 kilo of <i>mongo</i> beans• 1 can of assorted biscuits• 5 canned goods (with easy to open tabs or ready to eat <i>ulam</i>)	Hygiene Kit <ul style="list-style-type: none">• bath towels• alcohol• 3 bars of detergent soap• 3 bars of bath soap• 6pcs toothbrush• 1 tube toothpaste (100 grams)• 2 packs of sanitary pads• 2 rolls of toilet paper• wet wipes• 10-liter pail
Medicine <ul style="list-style-type: none">• betadine• 12 pieces of paracetamol• 6 pcs of anti-diarrhea• 6 pieces of pain relievers• medicated strips (1 pack of 10 pcs)	Others <ul style="list-style-type: none">• blankets• flashlight with batteries• thrash bags (medium)• mosquito net• <i>Dalangin ng Tomasino</i>

The relief box could temporarily provide needs of a family of 6 individuals for three to five days
