All love offerings and collections during the Mass will be forwarded to the Dominican Missions, specifically to the **St**. **Bartholomew Academy, Calayan** and the **Lyceum of Camiguin** in the Babuyanes Group of Islands. Meanwhile, checks may be made payable to the Dominican Province of the Philippines. All love offerings are to be coordinated with the UST Center for Campus Ministry for proper documentation.

The seating assignments and the route of entrance to the Grandstand, as well as the order of Faculties/Colleges for the recessional parade, will be sent to your office as soon as available. PRE-MASS PROGRAM

3:30

 The candidates for graduation of the different Colleges assemble inside their respective buildings.

4:30

- Candidates start to walk toward the Football Field passing through their designated entry points.
- Members of the Reception/Welcome Committee will lead them to their assigned seats upon arrival at the venue.
- The <u>academic officials</u> of each College are requested to lead the candidates for graduation to the Football Field.

5:30

PRE-MASS PROGRAM

- Entrance of the Philippine Flag and the UST Flag, followed by a National Anthem, to be led by the UST Symphony Orchestra, Coro Tomasino, and Liturgikon
- Introduction of Colleges, with flag bearers, accompanied by an AVP
- The faculty secretaries are requested to choose the flag bearers of their respective College for the presentation before the Mass proper. There will be a <u>rehearsal on Thursday, 23 May 2019 at 4:00 p.m.</u> at the Grandstand.

POST - MASS PROGRAM

- 7:15
- Recognition of the Colleges

- Each College is encouraged to come up with its own 'GIMMICKS" for a joyful ambience and spirit of celebration and thanksgiving after the Mass. However, please be guided by the following:
 - Students should wear the <u>clean and proper official TYPE</u> <u>A uniform</u>.
 - Hand-held props and other similar materials to add color and happy mood can be used for the gimmicks during the recessional parade.
 - There should be NO FIREWORKS/FIRECRACKERS, 0 SKY LANTERNS, CANDLE BALLOONS, HELIUM BALLOONS, FLOATING BALLOONS, CONFETTI, FOAM SPRAYS, PAINT SPRAYS, COLORED POWDER, PARTY POPPERS (BLIZZARDS), GLITTERS, ANIMALS, CAMERA DRONES (except the official photography drones), and AC-POWERED GADGETS/PROPS, during the walk/parade and the post-Mass program.
 - Since the students will pass through the Arch of the Centuries, there should be NO decorations or paraphernalia such as PAINT BRUSHES/SPRAYS, FOAM SPRAYS, and COLORED POWDER that would compromise the integrity of the heritage structure.
 - Please distribute the paraphernalia for the gimmicks such as clappers, masks, etc., immediately AFTER THE BACCALAUREATE MASS.

- Blessing and Imposition of the Thomasian Mission Cross
 - □ The Thomasian Mission Crosses to be used for the Imposition Ceremony, the candles and candle holders for the Ceremony of the Light, and Thomasian Pledge bookmarks will be claimed by the Colleges from the Office of the Secretary-General a day before the Baccalaureate Mass. <u>We request the College administration to decide</u> on the manner of distributing the Mission Crosses to the graduating <u>students</u>. However, please be advised that the Crosses should already be with them before they proceed to the Football Field.
 - Every College, represented by one candidate for graduation, <u>carrying</u> <u>their respective Mission Crosses</u> will be invited to come up the stage

for this ceremony. Each candidate for graduation will be accompanied by the respective Dean and Regent, who will impose on them their symbolic Thomasian Mission Cross.

- □ Simultaneously, for the graduating students in the audience, the Crosses distributed to them by the Colleges will be imposed, by one student on another student.
- Thomasian Pledge of Loyalty
- Ceremony of the Light
 - □ For the Ceremony of the Light, each graduating student should already have his/her candle with him/her. PLEASE ADVISE THEM THAT THE CANDLE SHOULD BE LIGHTED ONLY DURING THE CEREMONY OF THE LIGHT.
 - One of the servers will hand over the symbolic torch to the Father Rector. The Deans and Regents will light their corresponding torches from the Father Rector's torch. Candidates for graduation will receive their own light from the torches of their respective Deans and Regents.
 - □ The Office of the Secretary-General will distribute the candles and candle holders for the Ceremony of the Light a day before the Baccalaureate Mass.
