A versatile source of energy, light has become an attractive means to render polymers with arbitrary architectures even at microscale, which is realized through a technique known as two-photon stereolithography. These microstructures can be functionalized, again with the aid of light, to grant them molecular recognition properties. Once capable of recognizing target molecules, these microstructures rely on light as a carrier of information to signal the presence of molecules of interest.

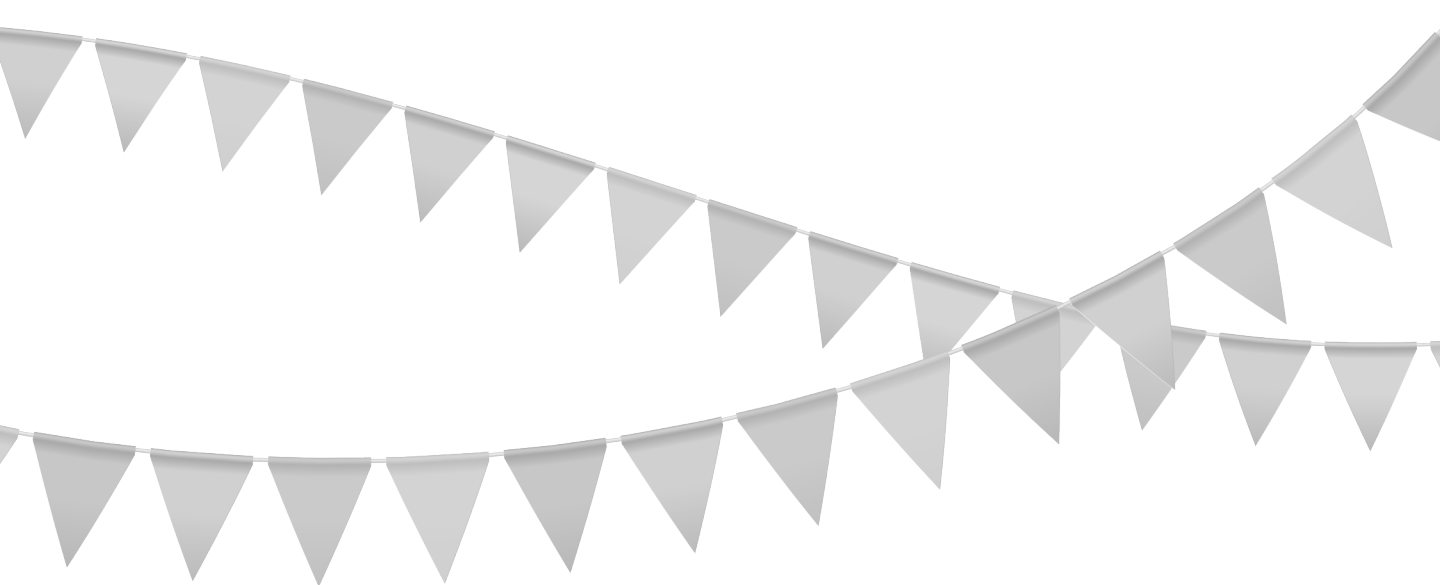
