Following the release of the activities for the Onboarding Season 2022-2023, the University, through the Center for Campus Ministry, issues the specific details of the Triduum Prayers and Masses for the **Solemnity of St. Dominic de Guzmán**, as follows:

- A. **The Triduum**, consisting of daily prayers and celebration of the Holy Eucharist, will be observed on **3-5 August 2022 (Wednesday to Friday)** at the **UST Chapel (Santisimo Rosario Parish Church)**. This year's theme is *"St. Dominic: Living the Truth, Walking in Hope, Serving in Charity."* Please see attached copy of the activities.
- B. **The University's Celebration** in honor of St. Dominic is set on **5 August 2022 (Friday)** at the **UST Chapel (Santisimo Rosario Parish Church)**. There will be a procession around the campus at 3:15 p.m. (see the attached file regarding the route), followed by the triduum prayer at 4:30 p.m., and the Eucharistic Celebration at 5:00 p.m.

The **sponsoring units** for each day of the Triduum Mass are kindly requested to:

- a) prepare a mass offering for the benefit of Santísimo Rosario Parish-UST to be offered by their respective representatives, and
- b) enjoin the administrative and academic officials, academic and support staff, and students to join in prayer via the livestream of the Facebook pages of the University ([UST1611official](#)) and Santísimo Rosario Parish ([SantisimoRosarioUST](#)).
- C. On **8 August 2022 (Monday)**, we remember our Holy Father Saint Dominic de Guzmán on his Solemnity. We mark this occasion as a special school holiday with **NO CLASS / NO OFFICE WORK** for the Thomasian community. Furthermore, the 7:30 a.m. Mass of the Parish in honor of St. Dominic will be streamed live via its official Facebook page.

We encourage the Thomasian community to partake in the celebration as an expression of reverence and devotion to St. Dominic. Thank you.
