The University, in coordination with the Department of Health-National Capital Region, Manila City Health Department, and the Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines (CBCP) will launch the **PINASLAKAS Nationwide COVID-19 Booster Vaccination Campaign** on **22 September 2022 (Thursday)** from **8:00 am - 5:00 pm** at the **UST Practice Gym**. This event is part of the government's program on rebuilding vaccine confidence and promoting booster doses for COVID-19.

All concerned administrators, academic staff, support staff, security and maintenance staff, and students, who have not yet received their booster doses, are *strongly encouraged* to participate in the COVID-19 Vaccination Program through the following reservation and registration system:

**A. University Staff and Students**

- Fill out the reservation form for the COVID-19 booster dose via **thomedss.ust.edu.ph** from **September 16-19, 2022**, and
- Register in the **manilacovid19vaccine.ph**.

**B. Direct-hired staff, including the dependents of the University staff**

- In lieu of filling out a registration form via the University's online medical support and services, signify your intention to register by sending an email to **healthservice@ust.edu.ph** using the subject heading **COVID-19 BOOSTER VACCINATION**, and
- Register in the **manilacovid19vaccine.ph**

To facilitate the booster vaccination, the proof of reservation and registration should be brought on the day of vaccination.


The following Health Protocols are to be observed during the said event:

1. All participants in the COVID-19 Vaccination Program are required to wear **well-fitted facemask**.
2. **Health Declaration Checklist** in ThOMedSS (for University Staff and Students) and StaySafe.PH app (for direct-hired staff and University staff dependents) must be accomplished prior to entry to the University.
3. All those with **COVID-19 symptoms** will NOT be allowed to enter the University premises.
4. **Minimum public health standards** must be observed at all times while inside the University.

Together, let us recognize the importance of COVID-19 booster as an added layer of protection in maintaining the health and safety of everyone.
