DURING THE ON-SITE ADMINISTRATIONS OF USTET
(DECEMBER 2022)**

The University, through the Office for Admissions (OFAD), announces the following updates concerning **schedules and timelines, drop-off and access points, entrance and exit gates, and entry protocols** during the *on-site* administration of the **UST Entrance Test (USTET)** this December 2022:

I. Schedules and Timelines

A. December 4, 2022 (Sunday) - College and LEAPMed USTET only

1. Test-takers with morning schedules
 - 4:00 am – opening of the campus gates
 - 5:00 am – admission of test takers to their respective buildings
 - 7:15 am – closing of building gates
 - 8:00 am – closing of campus gates (except for Gate 11)
2. Test-takers with afternoon schedules
 - 1:00 pm – admission of test takers for College USTET to their respective buildings

B. December 11, 2022 (Sunday) - USTET for SHS and JHS/EHS only

- 4:00 am – opening of the campus gates
- 5:00 am – admission of test takers to their respective buildings
- 7:15 am – closing of building gates
- 8:00 am – closing of campus gates (except for Gate 11)

The testing areas include the UST Main Building, Benavides Building, Thomas Aquinas Research Complex (TARC), St. Raymund de Peñafort Building, St. Martin de Porres Building, Albertus Magnus Building, Fr. Roque Ruaño, OP Building, Bl. Buenaventura García Paredes, OP Building, and Bl. Pier Giorgio Frassati, OP Building.

II. Drop-Off and Pick-up Points for Examinees and Companions

- **España Blvd** (near Gates 1, 2, and 6), and
- **Dapitan St.** (near Gates 10 and 11)

III. Entrance and Exit Gates for Pedestrians

1. USTET Examinees and Companions

- **Gate 1 (España Blvd)** for examinees assigned to Fr. Roque Ruaño Bldg.;
- **Gate 2 (España Blvd)** for examinees assigned to the Albertus Magnus Bldg.;
- **Gate 3 (España Blvd)** for examinees assigned to the Main Bldg.;
- **Gate 6 (España Blvd.)** for examinees assigned to Paredes Bldg.;
- **Gate 10 (Dapitan St.)** for examinees assigned to the Benavides Building and TARC;
- **Gate 11 (Dapitan St.)** for examinees assigned to St. Martin de Porres Bldg. and St. Raymund de Peñafort Bldg.; and
- **F. Cayco St. and Extramadura St.** for examinees assigned to the Frassati Bldg.

2. Parishioners and Visitors

- **Gate 7 (P. Noval St.)** shall serve as pedestrian entrance and exit for Parishioners.
- **Gate 14 (A.H. Lacson Ave.)** shall serve as pedestrian/vehicular entrance and exit for those reporting to or visiting the UST Hospital.

IV. Entry Protocols

- Examinees are required to:
 1. present their respective **test permits** for the QR code reading, and an accomplished *health declaration form* from either the ThOMedSS or StaySafe.PH app; and
 2. submit themselves for **thermal scanning**;
- Companions are required to:
 1. present their respective accomplished *health declaration form* from StaySafe.PH app, and
 2. submit themselves for **thermal scanning**

V. Waiting Area

- Companions are advised to proceed to the designated waiting areas.
- They are also invited to participate in the Sunday Mass at the UST Chapel or visit the UST Museum, kiosks of the USTore, or the store of the UST Publishing House.
