With deep sorrow, the University announces the passing of our beloved former *Dean of the UST Faculty of Medicine and Surgery (FMS)*,

†Ramón Lachica Sin, MD (1933 - 2023),

who was born on 10 September 1933 in New Washington, Aklan, and passed away on 18 January 2023 in Cardinal Santos Medical Center, San Juan City.

Dr. Sin finished his Doctor of Medicine degree from the UST FMS in 1955¹. He taught Pathology in the late 50s and served as *Medical Director of the Philippine Airlines Medical Division*.² In the University, he served as *Dean of the UST FMS* from 1992 to 1996, *Assistant to the Rector for External Affairs* in the late 2000s, *Assistant to the Rector for Grants and Endowments* and *Quadricentennial Committee Chair* in 2009.³

After the funeral service at UST, the remains will be flown to his hometown in Aklan.
