RE : PINASLAKAS FOLLOW-UP COVID-19 VACCINATION PROGRAM
DATE : 23 JANUARY 2023

The University, in coordination with the Manila Health Department and the Department of Health-National Capital Region, will hold the third run of the **PINASLAKAS COVID-19 booster vaccination on 1 February 2023 (Wednesday) at the UST Practice Gym from 8:00 am - 3:00 pm.**

All concerned University staff (i.e., administrative and academic officials, academic staff, support staff, security and maintenance staff) and students, parishioners of the Santísimo Rosario Parish-UST, and personnel of the UST Hospital (USTH), who have not yet received their booster doses, are strongly encouraged to participate in the COVID-19 Vaccination Program on a **first-come, first-served basis.**

Please be reminded of the following steps and requirements during the vaccination:

1. Log-on to **manilacovid19vaccine.ph** for registration.
2. Download and accomplish the **written consent form** that must be submitted upon registration.
3. Bring your **UST ID or any valid ID** and **proof of the previous COVID-19 vaccination.**
Note: There should be a 4-month interval from the last COVID-19 Vaccine and a 2-week interval from other vaccines received.

The following Health Protocols are to be observed during the said event:

1. All participants in the COVID-19 Vaccination Program are required to **wear well-fitted facemask.**
2. **Health Declaration Checklist** in ThOMedSS (for University Staff and Students) and StaySafe.PH app (for direct-hired staff, University staff dependents, Parishioners, USTH personnel and their dependents) must be accomplished prior to entry to the University.
3. All those with **COVID-19 symptoms will NOT be allowed** to enter the University premises.
4. **Minimum public health standards** must be observed at all times while inside the University.
