- Persons who are excused from fasting and abstinence are those outside the age limits, the physically or mentally ill, the frail, pregnant or nursing women, and manual laborers among others.
- Let us not grow tired of doing good in active charity towards our neighbors, and may we practice almsgiving by giving joyfully (cf. 2 *Cor* 9:7).

WHAT IS LENT?

Lent is a 40-day penitential season, beginning on Ash Wednesday, which serves as a preparation for the great celebration of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Fasting and abstinence, along with prayer and almsgiving, are the recommended practices of the Church for the season of Lent. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of obligatory fasting and abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are days of fasting and abstinence too, but fasting can be commuted with works of mercy.

Abstinence: 14 years old and above Fasting: 18-59 years old
