(UST KUMPILANG BAYAN 2023)

DATE : 18 FEBRUARY 2023

Baptism, the Eucharist, and Confirmation constitute the *Sacraments of Christian Initiation*, whose unity must be safeguarded.<sup>1</sup> Moreover, Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace.<sup>2</sup> For "by the **Sacrament of Confirmation**, [the baptized] are *more perfectly bound* to the *Church* and are *enriched with a special strength* of the *Holy Spirit*. Hence they are, as *true witnesses of Christ*, more strictly obliged *to spread and defend the faith by word and deed.*"<sup>3</sup>

The University, through the Center for Campus Ministry (CCM), announces the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation (*Kumpilang Bayan*) for the Thomasian Community on 15 April 2023 (Saturday), 2:00 p.m. at the UST Quadricentennial Pavilion. The following are required for those who wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation:

## A. Requirements

- 1. For Students: A candidate for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation must:
- be a *baptized* person, and provide a *photocopy* of one's *baptismal certificate*;
- have received the *First Holy Communion*;
- be at least 12 years old,
- be currently *enrolled in UST*;
- commit to practice the Catholic Faith; and
- choose *one or two sponsors* who are practicing Catholics and old enough to be godparents.
- **2. For UST and UST Hospital Staff and personnel** (i.e., regular staff, sub-contractual employees, security personnel, maintenance staff) who wish to be confirmed, kindly visit the Center for Campus Ministry, third floor of the Tan Yan Kee Student Center.

1. Complete two (2) onsite sessions (Modules 1 and 2) of Orientation and Catechetical Instructions at the CCM Multi-Purpose Room, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the UST Tan Yan Kee Student Center, on the following available schedules:
