The University, through the Office for Admissions (OFAD), announces the following updates concerning **timelines, testing venues, drop-off and access points, entrance and exit gates, and entry protocols** during the *on-site* administration of the **UST Entrance Test (USTET)** for College, and Senior High School on **12 February 2023 (Sunday)**:

## I. TIMELINES

Test-takers with morning schedules

- 4:00 am – opening of the campus gates
- 4:30 am – start of admission of test takers to their respective buildings
- 7:15 am – closing of building gates

## II. TESTING VENUES

The testing areas include the Benavides Building and St. Raymund de Peñafort Building.

## III. DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP POINTS FOR EXAMINEES AND COMPANIONS

- España Blvd (near Gates 2 and 6)
- P. Noval St. (near Gate 7)
- Dapitan St. (near Gates 10 and 11)

## IV. ENTRANCE AND EXIT GATES FOR PEDESTRIANS

  - Gate 2 (España Blvd)

2. Parishioners and Visitors

- Gate 7 (P. Noval St.) shall serve as pedestrian entrance and exit for Parishioners.
- Gate 14 (A.H. Lacson Ave.) shall serve as pedestrian/vehicular entrance and exit for those reporting to or visiting the UST Hospital.

V. ENTRY PROTOCOLS


- Examinees are required to:
  1. present their respective **test permits** for QR code scanning, and an accomplished **health declaration form** from either the [ThOMedSS](#) or [StaySafe.PH](#) app; and
  2. submit themselves for **thermal scanning**.
- Companions are required to:
  1. present their respective accomplished **health declaration form** from StaySafe.PH app; and
  2. submit themselves for **thermal scanning**.

VI. WAITING AREA

- Companions are advised to proceed to the designated waiting areas.
- They are also invited to participate in the Sunday Mass at the UST Chapel or visit the kiosks of the USTore.
