RE : CONTINGENCY PLANS FOR THE ANTICIPATED
WEEKLONG TRANSPORT STRIKE (March 6-12, 2023)

The University, in anticipation of a transport strike set from March 6-12, 2023 (Monday to Sunday), endeavors to ensure the continuity of its services to its stakeholders through the following contingency plans:

1. Teaching and Learning

- **The delivery of instruction shall be shifted to online classes;** thus, all students will have their academic engagements *virtually* via the UST Cloud campus;
- As necessary, instruction that may be carried out by academic staff inside the facilities *on campus* shall be coordinated with the academic unit heads to ensure the provision of manpower support;
- Internships, as previously scheduled, shall push through, subject to the work arrangements to be enforced by the training facilities.


2. Office Operations

- **Work arrangements for University staff shall be guided by announcements and/or directives to be issued by the appropriate offices** (i.e., Office of the Vice-Rector for University officials, Human Resource Department for support staff, and the Office of the Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs for academic and non-teaching staff).

3. Services to Stakeholders

- **Onsite transaction for essential services will be shifted online through the published online channels** (i.e., official e-mail address, virtual office, website, online systems, etc.).
