## GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION FOR THE CELEBRATION OF THE BACCALAUREATE MASS (including Pre-Event Activities and Post-Mass Program)

Class of 2023

## PREPARATORY GUIDELINES

- **ON DROP OFF AND PICK UP**: The University will observe a *Carless Day;* hence the graduating students are advised to be dropped off and fetched.
- **ON SAFETY AND SECURITY**: The Safety and Security Personnel shall require the participants to:
  - a. present their health declaration via the <u>ThoMedSS</u>;
  - b. undergo a thermal screening and inspection in their respective buildings; and
  - c. wear their face masks inside their respective buildings and observe the minimum health protocol.
- **ON PROPER ATTIRE**: Students should wear clean and proper official **Type A uniform**.
- **ON PROPS AND DESIGNS:** Each Academic Unit is encouraged to devise its unique strategies or *gimmicks* for a triumphant ambience and celebratory spirit of gratitude, but is guided by the following:
  - Costume masks, hand-held props, placards and other similar materials can be used during the processional and recessional parade.
  - There should be NO fireworks/firecrackers, sky lanterns, candle balloons, helium balloons, floating balloons, confetti, foam sprays, paint sprays, colored powder, party poppers (blizzards), glitters, animals, camera drones (except the official photography drones), and AC-powered gadgets/props, during the processional and recessional parade.
  - Battery-operated props can ONLY be turned on after the closing song of the Mass.
- ON PERSONAL PROVISIONS: The participating graduating students and academic staff advisers are encouraged to carry with them their umbrellas, light snacks, and drinking water (in personal tumblers and NOT disposable bottles) during the event.
- ON THE UNIVERSITY PROVISIONS: The *Thomasian Mission Crosses* for the Imposition Ceremony; the *candles and candle holders* for the Ceremony of the Light; and the *Thomasian Pledge bookmarks* should be claimed by the representatives of the respective academic units from the Office of the Secretary-General on or before <u>29 May 2023 (Monday)</u>.
  - The respective academic units shall determine the system of distribution of the aforementioned materials to the graduating students.
  - The crosses should already be with the graduating students BEFORE they proceed to the Open Field.

### ASSEMBLY IN RESPECTIVE HOLDING AREAS

• The graduating students of the different academic units **assemble inside their respective buildings for instructions.** 

4:30 pm

#### PROCESSIONAL MARCH

- The sound of a *tambuli* will signal the call for mobilization to the Open Field passing through their designated entry points, to be followed by the drum roll of the UST Yellow Jackets.
- Members of the *Reception/Welcome Committee* of the respective academic units will lead them to their assigned seats upon arrival at the venue.

5:30 pm

### PRE-MASS PROGRAM

- Opening Prayer to be led by the CCM Director.
- Introduction of Academic Units with flag bearers. Note: The Faculty/College Secretaries are requested to choose the flag bearers of their respective Academic Units.
- Entrance of the Philippine Flag and the UST Flag (c/o ROTC cadet/cadettes)
- Philippine National Anthem to be led by the Conservatory of Music

## MASS PROPER (6:00 pm)

### • **PROPER DISPOSITION**:

- The participants of the Mass are expected to dispose themselves properly for the full, conscious, and active participation in the Liturgy.
- To ensure the solemnity of the Mass, observe silence and listen attentively to the Homily, which is whole-heartedly dedicated to the graduating students.
- Gimmicks may ONLY be displayed/demonstrated during the actual recognition of Academic Units in the Post-Mass Program.
- **OFFERTORY**: The Faculty/College Secretaries are requested to choose a representative from their respective Academic Units, who will bring the love offering to the altar for the benefit of the Dominican Mission Schools of the Dominican Province of the Philippines.

### 4. BLESSING AND IMPOSITION OF THE THOMASIAN MISSION CROSS

- Academic Units will be called according to the order of the foundation year.
- Every Academic Unit, represented by one candidate for graduation, <u>carrying their</u> <u>respective Mission Crosses</u> will be invited to come up the stage for this ceremony.
- Each graduating student will be accompanied by their respective Deans and Regents, who will impose on them the symbolic Thomasian Mission Cross.
- For the graduating students in the audience, the Thomasian Mission Crosses will be *simultaneously* imposed by a student on the student next to him/her.

### 5. THOMASIAN PLEDGE OF LOYALTY

#### 6. CEREMONY OF LIGHT (LUMINA PANDIT)

- The candle should be with the graduating students beforehand, which should be lit ONLY during the *Ceremony of Light*.
- The Presider (Fr. Rector) will light the symbolic torch, and in turn, the Deans and Regents will light their corresponding torches from the Presider's torch. The graduating students will then receive their own light from the torches of their respective Deans and Regents.
- 7. UST HYMN (c/o Conservatory of Music)

#### 8. RECESSIONAL PARADE

- The Fr. Rector and the Fr. Secretary-General, together with the administrative and academic officials and the Marching Band, will lead the parade wherein the graduating students from the different Academic Units triumphantly walk through the Arch of the Centuries.
- The graduating students are reminded to be mindful of health and safety of oneself and others during the recessional walk, while still maintaining the solemnity of the event.
