The University, through the UST Hospital (USTH), announces the observance of the <u>World Patient Safety Day</u> on 17 September 2023 (Sunday), which aims to raise global awareness about patient safety and call for solidarity and united action to reduce patient harm. The Department of Health (DOH) adopts this year's theme: "Engaging patients for patient safety" with a slogan "Elevate the voice of patients!" For a meaningful celebration, the following activities and campaign materials are already lined up:
