The celebration of **World Teachers' Day (WTD) 2023** reminds us that teaching is a vocation, a calling, a lifelong commitment to shaping minds, nurturing dreams, and igniting the flames of curiosity within the hearts of students and learners.

The theme for WTD 2023 is "*Empowering Educators: Strengthening Resilience, Building Sustainability*." In these challenging times, teachers, indeed, have emerged as beacons of resilience, adapting and innovating for their students and learners.<sup>1</sup>
