RE : ACCESS AND TRAFFIC FLOW ON CAMPUS DURING THE
BARANGAY AND SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN ELECTIONS
(BSKE) FOR MANILA DISTRICT 4

DATE : 26 October 2023

The University, in partnership with the Commission on Elections (COMELEC), will host the **Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections** for the registered voters of thirty-three (33) barangays¹ of Manila District 4 on **30 October 2023 (Monday)**.

Eighty-four (84) cluster/group precincts that used to be assigned under Ramon Magsaysay High School, which is currently undergoing construction, will be distributed to the **Benavides Building** and **St. Raymund Peñafort Building**.

A. Ingress / Egress Days

- October 28 (Sat) and October 29 (Sun) are the ingress days.
- October 31 (Tue) and November 1 (Wed) are egress days.
- Concerned academic officials/staff are encouraged to:
 1. ensure that important files posted on bulletin boards of classrooms or hallways are properly secured;
 2. hallways are free from obstructions; and
 3. student lockers/lost and found cabinets are properly secured.

B. Drop-Off and Pick-up Points for Voters, Volunteers and COMELEC officials

- Vehicles are not allowed inside the enclosed portion of the campus; hence, voters and their companions, including PPCRV volunteers and COMELEC Officials may be dropped off or picked up along Dapitan St. (near Gates 10 and 11).

C. Entrance and Exit Gates

1. Voters and their companions

- Gate 10 (Dapitan St.) for pedestrian entrance/exit for voters assigned to the Benavides Building
- Gate 11 (Dapitan St.) for pedestrian entrance/exit for voters assigned to the St. Raymund Peñafort Building
- PPCRV Volunteers and COMELEC officials may use either Gate 10 or Gate 11.

2. Patients and Visitors to the UST Hospital

- Gate 14 (Lacson St.) for pedestrian and vehicular entrance/exit

3. Parishioners

- Gate 7 (P. Noval St.) for pedestrian and vehicular entrance/exit

D. Entry Protocols for Voters and their companions, Volunteers, and COMELEC officials

- The voters and their companions, including PPCRV volunteers, and COMELEC officials shall be subjected to the usual security inspection as they enter the campus gates.
- Those with symptoms (cough, cold, flu-like symptoms) are strongly encouraged to wear well-fitting face masks.

E. Signages and Maps

- To facilitate the smooth access to the buildings, large signages and maps are displayed for easy visibility.
