1. CARLESS DAY

- 13 December 2023 is declared as **Carless Day**¹. Vehicles of suppliers are allowed to enter the campus for delivery purposes only.

2. SUSPENSION OF CLASSES

- Classes will be suspended from 4:00 pm onwards.
- Students and University staff are strongly encouraged to participate in the Eucharistic Celebration.

3. ACTIVITIES AND GUIDELINES

A. UST Paskuhan Gift-Giving

- Dubbed as *Ningning 2023: Ang Busilak na Diwa ng Pasko ay Masisilayan sa Ngiti ng Bawat Pamilyang Tomasino*, this project encourages the Thomasian community to bring gifts-in-kind (i.e., school supplies and food items for *Noche Buena* packages) or share gifts in cash as they partake in the University's Christmas Feast on campus.
