A UST Paskuhan Community Gift-giving Project

A. Project Rationale

During the scheduled *Paskuhan Agape 2023*, the Thomasian community (*i.e.* administrators, academic staff, students, support staff) are encouraged to bring *gifts-in-kind* (*i.e.*, school supplies and food items for *Noche Buena* packages) or share *gifts-in-cash* as they partake in the University's Christmas Feast on campus. The alumni may also share their gifts through the Office for Alumni Relations.

The gifts to be collected from the Thomasian community will be sorted out and be shared with the beneficiaries accordingly, to be held through several Paskuhan Community gift-giving activities, namely,

1. ***AKaP (Agape para sa mga Kamanlalakbay ngayong Pasko)*** for the partner communities (December 11-19, 2023);
2. ***Sambahaginan*** for the University maintenance and security personnel (December 17, 2023);
3. ***Kaparokya*** for identified Parishioners of the Santisimo Rosario Parish-UST (December 20, 2023); and
4. ***KAAGAPAY (KAsama sa maAGAP na aksyon at Payo)*** for the sectoral groups providing assistance on safety and security (*i.e.*, barangay officials, Manila Police District (MPD), Sampaloc Fire Station (SFS), Manila Traffic and Parking Bureau (MTPB), and Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) (December 21, 2023).

B. Project Guidelines

For Academic Units (AU):

1. All AUs, in coordination with their respective Local Student Councils (LSCs) and CBOs (College-Based Organizations), are requested to bring *noche buena* packages or school supplies. Monetary donations are also accepted.
2. Depending on the AU's total population, a certain number of packages, whether *noche buena* packages or school supplies, are assigned (*Please see table at the last page*).



3. For donations-in-kind:
 - a. The LSCs must ensure that the items are in good condition and the food is within the prescribed shelf-life limit;
 - b. All donations must be well-documented; and
 - c. Please see list at the last page for the standard content.
4. The Central Student Council (CSC) and Student Organizations Coordinating Council (SOCC) will closely coordinate with the Central Board of LSCs and Board of Directors (BODs) of Recognized Student Organizations (RSOs) to execute and promote the donation drive.
 - a. The LSCs and BODs will be the primary point persons for their respective AU's donations.
 - b. The LSCs and BODs will decide on the manner of collection and turn over of donations.
 - c. The CSC and SOCC will provide the posters for publicity for the donation drive.
 - d. Regarding collection and turnover of the drop boxes containing donations-in-kind:
 - 1) The SOCC and CSC will collect the boxes (Deadline: December 10, 2023) and counter-check its contents.
 - 2) As soon as the AUs complete the number of assigned packages (even at an earlier date), they can turn them over to the CSC.
 - 3) In addition, the CSC-CommDev will also provide a master list or a tally sheet to serve as a guide upon turnover.
5. During the collection period (December 4-10, 2023):
 - a. The LSCs and BODs will turn over the drop boxes to the CSC and SOCC at the Tan Yan Kee Student Center Building once they have completed the number of assigned.
 - b. The drop-off locations of the donation boxes per LSC and BODs shall be found in the following buildings:

6. The monetary donations shall be coordinated with OSA, SIMBAHAYAN, the Office of Information and Communications Technology (OICT), and the Office of the Vice Rector for Finance.
 - a. Accepting monetary donations will start on the day of the Paskuhan *Agape* on December 13, 2023.
 - b. SIMBAHAYAN will coordinate on the manner of collecting the amount to be distributed to the partner communities.
7. For any inquiries, kindly coordinate with CSC and SOCC.

For Administrative Offices (AO):

1. All AOs will be requested to prepare donations-in-kind for the Paskuhan Community Gift-giving project (NINGNING 2023) in the form of *Noche Buena* Packages.
2. Depending on the AO, a certain number of packages are assigned (*Please see table at the last page*).
3. For donations-in-kind:
 - a. The AOs must ensure that the items are in good condition and the food is within the prescribed shelf-life limit;
 - b. All donations must be well-documented; and
 - c. Please see list at the last page for the standard content.
4. During the collection period (December 4-10, 2023):
 - Once the assigned packages are completed, the AOs will turn over the *Noche Buena* packages at the Tan Yan Kee Student Center Building.
