The University of Santo Tomas, in collaboration with Ateneo de Manila University, shall host the two (2)-day *International Conference on the Theology of the Priesthood* on February 13-14, 2024 (Tuesday and Ash Wednesday), at the Frassati Auditorium, UST Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, OP Building.

The Conference draws inspiration from research documents resulting from an International Symposium titled "For a Fundamental Theology of Priesthood" organized in Rome last February 17-19, 2022 by the Center for Research and Anthropology of Vocations.

His Eminence Marc Cardinal Ouellet, *Prefect Emeritus of the Dicastery of Bishops*, and **Rev. Fr. Philippe Capelle Dumont**, *Professor*, Faculty of Catholic Theology, University of Strasbourg, will serve as **Keynote Speakers** for the first day and second day of the conference, respectively. *Please see the attached program for reference*.

Following a hybrid format, the event is expected to be participated in by seminarians, priests, religious and lay professors of Theology, representatives of the Association of Catholic Universities of the Philippines (ACUP), Association of South and Southeast Asian Catholic Colleges and Universities (ASEACCU), the Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines (CBCP), seminaries in Manila and nearby provinces, and those who are interested in Theology of the Priesthood.
