STUDENTS IN THE AFTERMATH OF SUPER TYPHOON CARINA

The University suspends the delivery of onsite and online services to the public until 27 July 2024 (Saturday) to dedicate time for campus clean-up and allow internal stakeholders to attend to their personal concerns in the aftermath of Super Typhoon Carina.

For University staff and students who were affected by the onslaught of Super Typhoon Carina, the University offers the following support services:

1. <u>Online Medical Services through Health Service ThoMedSS</u> (<u>Thomasian Online Medical Services and Support</u>)

- a. Emergency Contact Information (Please See attachment)
- b. Access **information materials** on Leptospirosis Prevention and Treatment as well as for other conditions.
- c. Schedule **online medical consultations** on Leptospirosis Prophylaxis (24-72 hours after wading in floods) and Treatment for those who are sick or experiencing symptoms.

2. Psycho-Social Support and Interventions

- a. Counseling Services: Students who may need counseling services may contact their guidance counselors through the online platforms provided by the Counseling and Career Center.
- b. **Psychological Assessment and Interventions**: University staff who may need counseling services may consult the Clinical Psychologist at the Health Service or through the <u>Thomasian Mental Health Responders</u>.


3. Assistance in Loan Applications for University Staff

- University staff who may have financial needs may apply for the following loan options:
- a. SSS Calamity Loan using the SSS mobile application;
- b. **Pag-IBIG Fund Calamity** or **Multi-Purpose Loan** completing the printed form and submitting it to the Payroll Section of the Accounting Division of the Office of the Vice Rector for Finance (OVRF) for signature before submitting it to a Pag-IBIG branch; and
- c. **Emergency Loan** or **Retirement Loan** (for qualified tenured academic staff) accomplishing the required form and submitting it to the OVRF Payroll Section.
