The University, through the Office for Student Affairs and Tiger Media Network (UST Manila), and Office for Student Affairs (UST General Santos), announces the guidelines and program flow for the **UST Paskuhan Concert 2024**, #USTPaskuhan2024 #EverThankfulEverHopeful, for Thomasians, as follows:

1. **UST Manila (20 December 2024)**

**A. Carless Day and Access Plan**

- 20 December 2024 (Friday) is declared as *Carless Day*.
- Vehicles of performers and suppliers are granted access to the campus through Gate 5 (España Blvd.) and Gate 10 (Dapitan St.) for deliveries within a limited time.
- Parishioners of the Santísimo Rosario Parish and visitors to the UST Hospital are provided with separate access to the campus. *Please see Attachment No. 1 for the access plan for students and University staff, performers and suppliers, parishioners, and visitors to the UST Hospital.*

**B. Security Inspection Guidelines**

**C. Health and Safety Reminders**

**D. Activities**

1. **Merrython: The 2024 Paskuhan Fairgrounds** is open to all students and University staff and will take place from 8:00 am – 3:00 pm at the Plaza Mayor.
2. **The UST Paskuhan Raffle**, facilitated by the UST Purchasing Office and TigerTV, will take place from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM at Plaza Mayor and streamed live on [TigerTV](#).
3. **Balik Bote, Balik Lata Drive**. The University, in partnership with San Miguel Yamamura Packaging Corporation (SMYPC), will launch a recycling awareness campaign for food and beverage glass containers and aluminum cans, with fun activities for students.
4. **UST Paskuhan Concert** officially begins at 3:00 pm and ends at 9:00 pm with a **Fireworks Display**.







**2. UST General Santos (18 December 2024)**

Students, university staff, alumni, and other stakeholders gather to celebrate the time-honored tradition of Paskuhan at UST General Santos. The celebration includes highlights such as *Panunuluyan*, the Paskuhan Mass, concert performances, and a spectacular fireworks display, marking a significant and historic first as the Thomasian community comes together in gratitude and hope. The schedule is as follows:

<b>8:00 am – 8:45 am</b>	<b><i>Panunuluyan</i></b> A traditional re-enactment of the journey of Mary and Joseph seeking a place to stay in Bethlehem.
<b>8:45 am – 9:00 am</b>	<b>Preparation for the Holy Mass</b> A brief period for disposing oneself for the solemn Paskuhan Mass, setting the tone for reflection and reverence.
<b>9:00 am – 10:00 am</b>	<b>Paskuhan Mass</b> Very Rev. Fr. Richard G. Ang, OP, Rector, will preside and deliver the homily, focusing on the theme 'Ever Thankful, Ever Hopeful'.
<b>10:00 am – 10:30 am</b>	<b>Photo Opportunities</b> An opportunity to capture memories of the Paskuhan Mass and the celebration's milestones.
<b>10:30 am – 4:00 pm</b>	<b>Preparation for the Paskuhan Concert</b>
<b>5:30 pm – 6:00 pm</b>	<b>Arrival of Guests</b> The arrival of guests is greeted with the lively USTe chants and drum performances, adding to the festive atmosphere.
<b>6:00 pm – 9:00 pm</b>	<b>Paskuhan Concert</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ This event features dance performances, a play, violin, and band performances.</li><li>○ Each student is given five (5) tickets to serve as a gate pass for their family members and/or close friends.</li><li>○ Alumni will also participate.</li></ul>
<b>9:00 pm</b>	<b>Fireworks display</b> A spectacular fireworks display to cap off the Paskuhan celebration, symbolizing gratitude and hope.
