**A. UNIVERSITY STUDENT AWARDS DAY | 23 May 2025, 9:00 am, Quadricentennial Pavilion**

- The University bestows her highest distinction to individuals and groups, who exemplify Thomasian excellence in the fields of academics, community development, leadership, teamwork, sports and the arts.
- Academic Units, including the Basic Education Cluster, and the Office for Student Affairs also have their respective local Recognition Days.

**B. BACCALAUREATE MASS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION and  
THANKSGIVING MASSES FOR BASIC EDUCATION**

- The celebration of the Baccalaureate Mass will be held on 30 May 2025 (Friday) at the UST Grandstand and Open Field, at 4:00 pm. The Post-Mass Program includes the *Ceremony of Light*, Conferment of the *Thomasian Mission Cross*, the Recitation of the *Thomasian Pledge of Loyalty* and the Traditional Exit through the historic *Arch of the Centuries*.
- Thanksgiving Masses for Basic Education are likewise set before their completion ceremonies/commencement exercises (*See Attachment*).

**C. SOLEMN INVESTITURE RITES FOR HIGHER EDUCATION,  
COMPLETION CEREMONIES/ MOVING-UP CEREMONIES FOR GRADE 10 and  
COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES FOR GRADE 12 | 9 May 2025 to 1 July 2025**

- The Rites shall be held at the Quadricentennial Pavilion Arena, the Medicine Auditorium, the Albertus Magnus Auditorium, and the UST Chapel (*See Attachment*).
- The academic units are requested to keep the ceremonies concise and solemn, adhering to the prescribed program.
